

Joaquin Sorolla (1863-1923) - Return of the boat. The Beach in Valencia 1909

This picture was painted by Joaquin Sorolla in 1909.

He was a Spanish painter who mainly painted landscapes and portraits; he always painted sunlight which reminded him of his home.

He suffered a stroke in 1920 while painting and was paralysed for over three years; he died on 10 August 1923.

Max Liebermann (1847-1935) - On the Alster in Hamburg 1910

Max Liebermann painted the "On the Alster in Hamburg" but only in his late days, first he painted upper class men.

Then he moved to the Wannsee and started painting landscapes.

He painted this picture in 1910 on the shore of the Wannsee.

He died at the age of 88.

Claude Monet (1840-1926) - Sunrise 1872

Claude Monet is one of the most well-known impressionist painters.

He and his friends were looking for new ways to paint pictures especially light, during experimenting they established what is known today as impressionism.

"Sunrise" is one of his best known paintings.

He died on 5 December, 1926.

Szinyei Merse Pál (1845-1920) - Sailboat on the see 1903

Szinyei Merse Pál was a well-known Hungarian impressionist painter.

He painted portraits in the early years and took a break from painting,

He didn't want to get back to painting but his friends and relatives put pressure on him.

After this he painted landscapes.

He died in 1920 in Slovakia.
